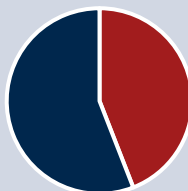

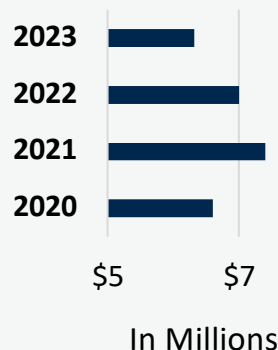
Basic living expenses (food, lodging, utilities, household set-up)	24,890
